The WNG Chair's rounded shape is puffed up with the upholstery, which enhances its childlike chubbiness, and invites you to sit, like a baby elephant tempting you to take a ride on its back.

## General information

DESCRIPTION	The WNG Chair is constructed of a seat and back in laminated molded veneer. The two parts are joined together with a steel fitting milled into the two 12mm shells. WNG chair is only available fully upholstered. The chairs padding is produced from molded (pp foam).
VERSION	Fully upholstered in fabric/leather. Base/legs: Solid oak wood with natural colored oil surface treatment.
PRICE GROUPS	1 to 6 Sheepskin COM & COL
ACCESSORIES	Felt gliders are standard.
ENVIRONMENT	Parts can be separated and sorted for recycling.
TESTS	Foam is fire retardant according to California Technical Bulletin 117. Foam according to BS 5852, Crip 5, is available on request.  Chair fulfils the requirements in EN 16139:2013. Loading according to Test severity L1.

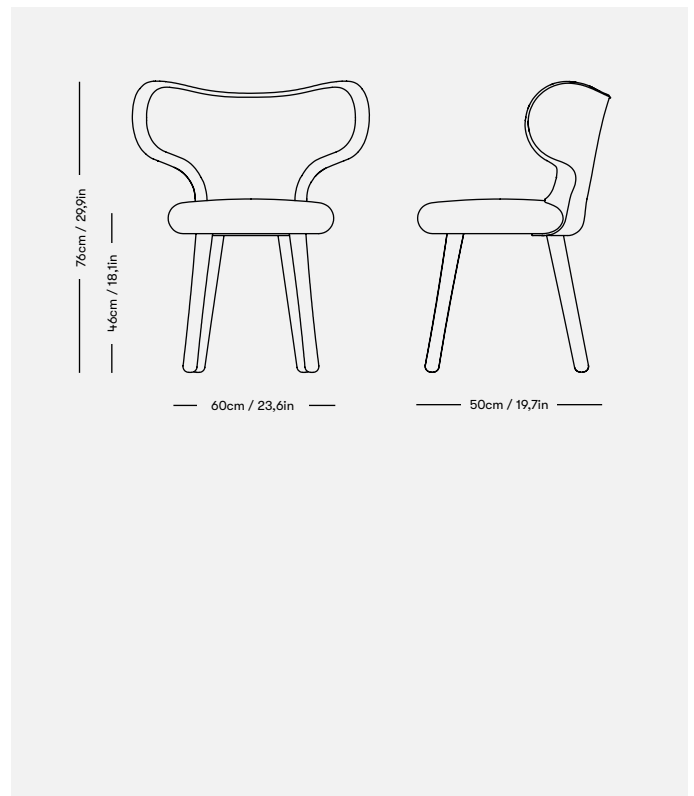

## Cleaning & maintenance

---

**CLEANING**            For cleaning the upholstered surface, first try to brush off the dirt gently. If this is not enough, then vacuum the surface. If further cleaning of the upholstery is needed, a stain remover is recommended. The cleaning must be gentle and must always be tested on the most invisible area of the surface before the actual cleaning. Avoid blotches by gentle, circular rubbing towards the stain. To avoid stains, quickly remove the dirt with a piece of absorbing household wipe and clean with water and colorless washing-up liquid. Do not use the following products for the padding:

- Undiluted cleaning liquids.
- Bleach.
- Ammoniac.
- Soap for hard surfaces.

For dusting and light cleaning of the frame use a soft, dry cloth. For further cleaning of the frame, use a soft cloth that is firmly wrung in clean water for gently wiping the surface, and then immediately use a dry cloth to wipe the surface again. Do not use materials for maintenance that:

- Contain abrasive agents.
- Are basic, acidiferous, or organic.

For the best maintenance of the product, protect it against sunlight and heat, and try to keep it away from moisture, grease, and other dirt. Furthermore, protect the surfaces against sharp objects and other that might scratch.

**MAINTENANCE**        We recommend to re-oil once a year.
